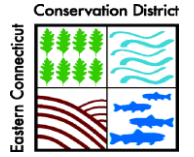

A rain barrel is connected to a gutter downspout to collect rainwater. The rainwater is then used to water gardens or plants in your yard. Rain barrels also help to keep neighborhood streams and ponds clean by preventing dirty water from entering them.
